## NOTICE OF RACE

**The Nautical Club of Paleon Faleron is organizing  
the Open Optimist Sailing Regatta “NCPF CUP”  
and the perpetual “4<sup>th</sup> N. SARIKAVAZIS TROPHY”  
from 16<sup>th</sup> to 18<sup>th</sup> November 2018**

### **1. REGULATIONS**

The race will be governed by the regulations as defined in ISAF 2017-2020 Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) and the Optimist class rules.

Rule 61.1 adds: A boat intending to protest must inform the Race Committee against which boat the protest will be made, immediately after finishing race.

### **2. ADVERTISING**

Boats displaying advertising must have approval of the HSF (Greek Athletes) or their MNA (Foreign Athletes), a copy of which must be submitted to the race secretariat.

### **3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRIES**

3.1. Eligible to participate are the athletes who were **born in 2003 and after**. Foreign competitors shall be in compliance with their respective national regulations.

3.2. The entry fee is set at **Euro fifteen (€ 15)**. The Organizers will provide lunch box before the start at the NOPF.

3.3. Entries must be submitted until Friday 9<sup>th</sup> November 2018 via e-mail [trophy@nopf.gr](mailto:trophy@nopf.gr). Entries will be valid if they are accompanied by the following forms:

- Registration Form
- Support Boat Registration Form
- Valid insurance for the Dinghies and the Support Boats
- Support Boat Driving Licence

### **4. PROGRAMME**

- Friday 16/11 09:00-12:00 Registration (**Only the original Registr. Form**)
- Friday 16/11 13:30 Races
- Saturday 17/11 11:00 Races
- Saturday 17/11 17:30 Party
- Sunday 18/11 10:00 Races – Prize Giving Awards / Closing Ceremony

The Regatta is scheduled for nine (9) races. There will not be held more than 4 races per day. On Sunday 18<sup>th</sup> November 2018 there will be no warning signal after 15:00

### **5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

The sailing instructions will be available at the Registration Desk on Thursday 15/11 from 09:30. **The Sailing Instructions will determine how athletes or their coaches will indicate arrival and departure times, which is mandatory.**

### **6. VENUE**

The races will be held at Faliron Bay.

### **7. ROUTE**

Details of the route will be announced in the Sailing Instructions.

## **8. RANKING**

8.1 Will be applied the Low Point System, Appendix A of the RRS.

8.2 Must be made at least 2 races for the regatta to be valid.

8.3 With 3 races accomplished, all will be calculated for the rating of a boat. Accomplishing 4 or more races, the worst race will be excluded.

## **9. PENALTIES**

9.1 If not stated by the athletes or their coaches arrival and departure times from the port, the athlete will be deemed DNC.

9.2 Coaches when departing and arriving at Flisvos Marina should be tuned to channel 9

9.3. The coaches at the departure and arrival in Marina Flisvos should be tuned to channel 9.

9.3 Other penalties as specified in the Sailing Instructions.

## **10. SUPPORT BOATS**

The accompanying boats must be reported to the Registration Desk. Operators should be responsible for their movements, wear safety bracelet (quick-stop) connected to the ignition.

## **11. HOSPITALITY**

Participating Clubs are welcome to be accommodated on the NCPF's facilities. They should inform the secretariat of the NCPF (name and car number plate) for entering access.

## **12. PRIZES**

Prizes will be awarded to the following classes for the first 3 winners: Boys - Girls, 11 y.o. boys, 11 y.o. girls (born in 2007 later) and to the best team. Sponsors' gifts will be awarded. The ceremony will be held on Sunday 18/11/2018 at 17:00 in the NCPF's facilities.

## **13. LIABILITY**

All athletes compete according to the fundamental rule 4 RRS-ISAF. The organizing Nautical Club and Committees shall not hold any responsibility for anything that happens to people both on land and at sea during the race.

## **14. INSURANCE COVERAGE**

All racing and accompanying vessels should have at least what is required by the Greek legislation insurance liability of 540.000 euro to third parties.
